

# The Dutch Planning system

Local	Municipal Council Municipal Executive	Local Zoning Scheme Project decision





### Organisational structure of planning

National government; overall planning and legislation

**Regional government**; regional planning and control on local authorities

**Local municipalities**; detailed plans and awarding construction measures according to the locally adapted building code.

AND





#### Independent water authorities

Water boards; independent authorities responsible for most waterways, water treatment and water management (charged with an additional tax directly to citizens)

Established around 1200

Safeguard roughly the 60% of the Dutch population (16,5 million) in the lowlands from flooding and guarantee the water quality of the surface water (95 % of the sewage water is purified).



# Public information on soil quality and the value of the property



Gobal trend; Growing weals is more attention to health

Evaporation or attached pollution from your owned soil therefore reduct property value by at least to cost for cleaning up.

In NL the price of clean land ranges from € 2000-1200 for (Sub-)urban areas to € 3-3 agricultural land. (up to 50% of intial construction costs)

Low energy e.g, using surface cooling high rise covers costly ground treatment







#### Conclusions

Lack of space (especially in cities) when growing wealth will promote soil remediation.

Rediscovered approach, "build with Nature" instead of dig and dispose.

may add value with the ever yielding energy prices
